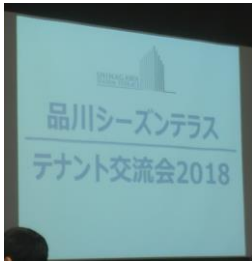
This event used to be once a year. However, due to its popularity among relevant industries, it will be held twice a year starting from 2019.
